Date: November 26, 2022 Time: 10:00AM-12:00 Noon

Staging Area: Martin Luther King, Jr. Middle School-1000 Mosby Street, Richmond, Virginia **Disbanding Area:** Armstrong High School-2300 Cool Lane

- Staging area will open at 8:00AM
- Parade Units and vehicles MUST be in their staging area by 8:45am, no later than 9:00AM
- First roll call by Parade Captains will be conducted at 9:15am
- Final roll call will be conducted at 9:50am

Parade Route: From MLK Middle School, the parade units will make a left turn onto Mosby Street. Mosby Street turns into Mechanicsville Turnpike. All units will proceed on Mechanicsville Turnpike to Cool Lane. The parade units will then make a right turn on Cool Lane and proceed to Armstrong High School. All parade units will then make a left turn into the AHS Parking Lot and proceed to the disbanding area. Special instructions will be provided for extra large vehicles.

High School Band Participation:

- Each High School Band participating in this year's parade will receive a participation Trophy and lunch will be provided.
- Each High School Band can also participate in the Drum Line Show Case, immediately following the Parade. (See registration form)

Rules and Regulations:

• The AW Football Classic Legacy Parade is a family-friendly event for all ages, and every unit in the parade is expected to respect this. Failure to comply may result in in termination of participation.

• Parade officials and the Richmond City Police prohibit the throwing of any Items from parade participants.

• No Alcohol or Guns (except those worn by Law Enforcement Officers) are permitted.

Weather: The parade will be cancelled if on Friday, November 25th, the weather forecast calls for 60% Chance of inclement weather.

Notables and Dignitaries:

- Parking will be located at Armstrong High School and a shuttle will be provided to the Parade Staging area. This is where you will enter your parade vehicle, <u>if you decide to park at MLK</u>, <u>please indicate on your registration form</u>.
- Legacy Participants (Cheerleaders, Football Players, Homecoming Queens, or Majorettes or anyone who was a part of the Classics between 1938-1978): Parking will be located at Armstrong High School and a shuttle will be provided to the Parade Staging area. This is where you will enter your parade vehicle. Street Parking is also available.
- When you arrive, please find your Division's staging area located in the rear of MLK Middle School. Your Division area will be clearly marked with signage. There will be a Division Captain located in your staging area who will provide further instructions.
- All parade participants MUST arrive at your designated Division area before 9:30am in order to participate. The parade will promptly begin at 10:00am.
